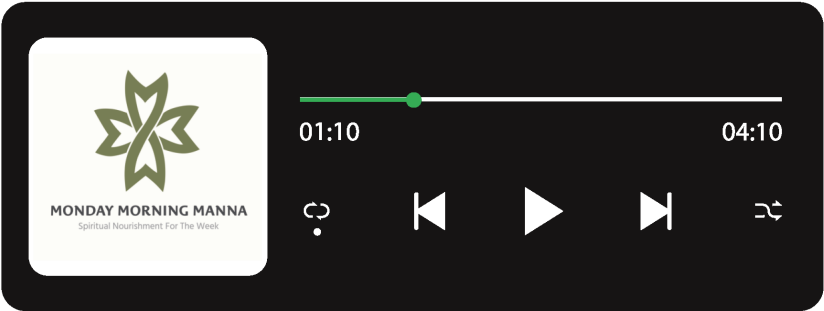

## CHAPEL CONSTRUCTION UPDATE – NEARING COMPLETION!



We're thrilled to share that the Chapel at Holy Land Farms is nearly finished! The team has made incredible progress in recent weeks. Here's what's been accomplished:

- Insulation is complete, ensuring the Chapel will be cozy in winter and cool in summer.

- Electrical wiring is fully installed, bringing us one step closer to full functionality.
- HVAC is installed
- All wood has been installed and stained
- The cedar shake roof is beautifully finished, giving the Chapel its timeless, rustic charm.
- The ceiling is up and stained, and the exposed beams add warmth and character to the interior.
- Our stunning 12-foot-tall windows are being fabricated, with hopes to install them later this summer.
- The stained glass for the tower is currently in production—adding a sacred, colorful touch.
- The bell has been delivered and we are in final stages of fabrication with installation planned first of August.

## THE CROSS IS UP! A Powerful New Landmark at Holy Land Farms

The 64-foot cross has officially taken its place at Holy Land Farms, standing tall and proud overlooking the lake. After a journey down Interstate 75, the monumental symbol of faith was carefully assembled at its new permanent home, marking a moment of celebration and spiritual reflection for all involved.



A dedicated team worked tirelessly to complete the fabrication and installation of the cross. As the final pieces came together, supporters and members of the community gathered on-site to pray over the cross—a moving moment of unity and reverence before it was hoisted high into the sky.

Now fully assembled and freshly painted, the cross stands as a powerful beacon of hope and faith. Plans are underway to install permanent lighting, which will illuminate the cross against the night sky.
